RE: Placer County Water Agency's Comments on the Final Delta Plan

Dear Chair Isenberg and Members of the Council:

Placer County Water Agency (Agency) would like to express its appreciation for the opportunity to participate in the development of the Delta Plan (Plan). As you are probably aware, throughout the process the Agency has actively monitored the progression of Drafts, and has provided comments as an individual commenter as well as through its active involvement in the ACWA Ag-Urban Committee, the North State Alliance, the Regional Water Authority and the Mountain Counties Water Resources Association. The Agency's consistent and constant message has been that the Council's authority is limited to actions taking place in the legal Delta and that upstream areas, such as Placer County, cannot physically reduce their reliance on water in the Delta watershed to less than 100%; there are no other sources of water.

We have provided suggestions and comments to the Council and to its staff, and the final Plan demonstrates that our voice has been heard. While we remain disappointed that the Plan continues to echo the statute's requirement for "reduction" of reliance on Delta watershed water, we appreciate the text and examples in the Plan that clearly explain that this means, for upstream users, the increase in water use efficiency and development of integrated regional water management plans.

Further, the Plan clearly sets forth the limitation of the Council's jurisdiction to actions occurring within the legal Delta by its definition of "covered action," a subject of considerable debate, comment and conversation with the Council and its staff. The Agency appreciates this clarity.


